


Rate of change in the general index of industrial production

KSA Leadership Globally Enhanced by Robotics



The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is taking accelerated steps in robotics and expanding applicability more effectively in the government, business sector and society, thus enhancing its presence and prominence as a developed country and a global leader in various industrial, technical and technological fields in such a manner as to achieve the goals set for Vision 2030.

With the great efforts of transformation coming into play across the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia at all levels since the ambitious launch of Vision 2030 to date, all public and private entities are making more progress and headway to adopt state-of-the-art and cutting-edge technology, innovation and invention, and the transfer of modern techniques and technology that contribute to bringing the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia closer to the knowledge-based economy, while further enhancing the global position of the nation and all citizens.

Such concerted efforts have been translated into reality in several aspects; the first robot has been appointed in a Saudi government entity in the Technical and Vocational Training Corporation (TVTC), nicknamed TEQANI, as it supports customer service via an electronic evaluation device and delivers messages to visitors to the associated exhibitions and activities. The General Organization for Social Insurance (GOSI) also launched the Digital Human to further facilitate services for customers and subscribers.

In the same vein, Dr. Faisal Al-Sarheed successfully developed and manufactured a robot, nicknamed MUSLIM as it can speak the Arabic language and the colloquial dialect. Dr. Al-Sarheed further added that he derived his idea from the published talk about the Artificial Intelligence (AI) threats, stressing that he was much motivated by the efforts made by the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia about robotics.

Of great note, Dr. Al-Sarheed successfully produced the robot within the framework of a special 8-month research project; all the preparatory efforts were entirely achieved in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, much aided and supported by talented Saudis. Equally important, Dr. Al-Sarheed spelled out that the robot has memorized the whole verses of the Holy Quran and some selected teachings of the Prophet's Sunnah, in addition to general information about the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, pointing out that the robot can also use AI techniques to learn more following each and every discussion.

In the opening ceremony of the LEAP Conference 2023 in Riyadh, The Saudi-Made interactive robot nicknamed SARA welcomed and guided the attendees. It was manufactured in close cooperation between the Saudi Digital Company and QSS. It has featured unique communication capabilities of interacting with all visitors, performing all popular dances, and responding to inquiries.

Robot SARA is equipped with an AI-empowered camera; it can recognize the distance of people around it with a high precision. Impressively enough, Robot SARA begins a conversation session once a visitor speaks out [Hello, Sarah]. It is based on a pre-trained model that recognizes different Saudi dialects, analyzes sentences and understands content and provides appropriate answers in text format.

SIDF Celebrates 45 Graduates of NOKHAB Program



Under the auspices of His Excellency Mr. Bandar bin Ibrahim Al-Khorayef, Minister of Industry and Mineral Resources and Chairman of the SIDF Board of Directors, and His Highness Prince Sultan bin Khalid bin Faisal, SIDF CEO, SIDF celebrated the graduation of the third cohort of the NOKHAB program that leads to employment opportunities.

The graduates came out in three pathways: Credit (29 graduates), Engineers (8 graduates), and Market Studies (8 graduates). All the 45 graduates successfully completed credit training based on an integrated ecosystem of theory and practice well designed and tailored to best achieve the aspirations and goals of Vision 2030 in such a manner as to develop highly qualified and trained national human resources to further lead the industrial economy.

Since it was first launched in 2019, a whole host of 74000 applicants registered for the NOKHAB program, of whom 274 male and female trainees were accepted, distributed among the three Programs :



with male trainees accounting for 53% of all cohorts and female trainees making up 47%.

Know-vember Month by SIDF

Know-vember Month by SIDF activities attracted a whole host of people, gathering at the SIDF Auditorium and virtually online via the live stream channel on YouTube. It further contributed to promoting the knowledge generated and provided by SIDF on society, emphasizing its role as a source of knowledge ever since it was established to date.
